

ENROLMENT INTO BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAMMES IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022

Candidates of EU Member States

Citizens of European Union Member States and foreign citizens who have permanent residence in Slovenia who (or whose parents) are taxpayers in Slovenia can apply for the enrolment places for Slovenian citizens published in the Call for Slovenian Enrolment:

- First application period: **from February 16 to March 19, 2021**
- Second application period: **from August 20 to August 27, 2021**
- The application in the last term for enrolment: **September 23 and 24, 2021** (until 12.00 pm)

Candidates are required to submit their applications online through the [eVŠ](#) web portal:

- **without a qualified digital certificate (with username and password):** the enrolment application form must be submitted online through the eVŠ web within the application deadline with the required attachments to the application.

APPLICATION DATES

First application period: from February 16 to March 19, 2021

- The application for enrolment should be submitted electronically through web portal [eVŠ](#) **from February 16 to March 19, 2021**.
- Supplemental documents should be submitted electronically through web portal [eVŠ](#) **until August 6, 2021**).

An application is considered to be submitted in time if it has been completed online through the eVŠ web portal within the application deadline (**March 19, 2021**) and **supplemental documents submitted until August 6, 2021**).

Second application period: from August 20 to August 27, 2021

- The application for enrolment should be submitted electronically through web portal [eVŠ](#) from **August 20 to August 27, 2021** with supplemental documents.

An application is considered to be submitted in time if it has been completed and submitted with supplemental documents online through the eVŠ web portal (**with user name and password**) within the application deadline (**August 27, 2021**).

The application in the last term for enrolment: September 23 and 24, 2021 until 12.00 pm

During this period, the following candidates may apply for still-available enrolment places:

- candidates who did not apply in the first- or second-round application period,
- candidates who have submitted their first or second application and have not been admitted to any of the chosen study programmes listed in their application in the selection procedure of the current year,
- candidates admitted in the first- or second-round application period in a study programme which will not be implemented.

- The application for enrolment should be submitted electronically **with user name and password** through the eVŠ web portal **from September 23 to September 24, 2021 until 12.00 pm** with supplemental documents.

An application is considered to be submitted in time if it has been completed and submitted online through the eVŠ web portal by the application deadline with supplemental documents **(September 24, 2021 until 12.00)**.

Supplemental documents:

1. **the final certificate** of completed education (final certificate of a four-year secondary school). The document must be legalized* on the basis of:
 - the Hague Conventions of 1961 (in the court of territorial jurisdiction where the certificate was obtained), the APOSTILLE mark must be duly completed, or
 - The Act on the Certification of Documents in International Traffic.

* Legalization of the original certificate of education is not required in cases where it is completely abolished by the bilateral agreement (Austria, Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Czech Republic, France, Greece, Croatia, Hungary, Republic of Northern Macedonia, Serbia).
2. **certified** (by court) **Slovene translation of the original of the final certificate** referred to in No 1,
3. **the annual report cards**, transcripts, a diploma supplement or some sort of other evidence on the contents and duration of education for the last two years of secondary school,
4. **certified** (by court) **Slovene translation of the documents** referred to in No 3,
5. **the annual report cards**, transcripts, a diploma supplement or some sort of other evidence on the contents and duration of education for the first two years of secondary school,

6. short chronological description of the entire completed education

(written and signed by the applicant)

7. passport

Certificates that do not require recognition:

- Certificates from the former Yugoslav republics obtained before June 25, 1991.
- International Baccalaureate (IB) certificates are equivalent to matura certificates obtained in the Republic of Slovenia and do not require recognition.
